Agreement and Release of Liabilities for Site Known as West Rutland, or Hanley Mountain

As lawful consideration for being permitted to use this site, I agree that I, my heirs, distributees, guardians, assigns and legal representatives will not make any claims against, sue, attach the property of, or prosecute any landowners or other flyers at this site. The United States Hang Gliding and Paragliding Association are also included under this waiver.
